In 2024 we will be teaching Performing Arts, which will involve dance, drama and music. Elissa Chillingworth will be our new Performing Arts teacher.




Meet the Teacher 2024- Tuesday, 23rd January 2024

Thank you to all who attended, may there be love and light in your family's life always.






